This tenure track or continuing track Assistant Professor position begins in August 2019. Applicants for this position should have extensive professional experience that support the goals of the Sport Management major, previous teaching experience and plans for future scholarship in the areas of sport communication, analytics and/or law. A terminal degree in Sport Management or a related field is required.

Sport Management (SPT) faculty teach a maximum of six courses per academic year that support the undergraduate major and Elon's Core Curriculum.
