Assistant Professor of Sport Management

Elon University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Sport Management, beginning mid-August, 2022. The Sport Management major prepares students for the business of sport, including professional sport, college athletics, and sport-related agencies. Through extensive practical applications, students develop an understanding of community and global service, with an emphasis on leadership and professional skill development.

Candidates must have a terminal degree in a related discipline and must have a track record of peer-reviewed scholarship commensurate with the appointed rank. Applicants who are ABD with dissertations near completion before August 2021 will be considered.

Teaching may include Contemporary Sport Management, Research Methods, Sport Marketing, Sport Law, Event Management, Sport Finance, Facilities and Venue Management and courses in the Elon Core Curriculum. Other elective courses can be taught and developed. Additional responsibilities include advising students, mentoring undergraduate research, and serving on committees at the department, school and university level. Candidates who have experience working with a diverse range of people, and who can contribute to the climate of inclusivity are encouraged to identify their experiences in their cover letter.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Applications that are received by October 22 will be assured of consideration.
