Preferred Qualifications: Ph.D. or Ed.D in Sport Management or a closely related discipline from an accredited institution or a Juris Doctor (J.D.) from an ABA-accredited institution with a demonstrated record of achievement in teaching, academic research, and service in sport management and an established research agenda including experience/interest in grantsmanship. Online teaching familiarity, a demonstrated commitment to student mentoring, dedication to experiential learning utilizing high impact practices, and experience with curriculum development and COSMA accreditation are preferred.

The successful candidate will teach various face to face and/or online undergraduate courses in the Sport Management program. The department has a particular need for an individual with expertise in one or more of the following areas:
